Bulletin 12th April 2026

Divine Mercy Sunday was instituted by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000 to be celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. He described Divine Mercy Sunday as “*a time where we are blessed with divine mercy as it reaches us through the heart of Christ Crucified.*”

Those beautiful words need to become alive and active in those who have been called by Jesus to be His followers. That is, in you and me. Never before has there been more need for mercy and forgiveness. Our prayer and our works of mercy are urgently needed in so many places today. There are great numbers of children who are starving with broken-hearted parents who have nothing with which to feed them. Families are told that it is not safe to continue living in their homes, but they have nowhere to go. People are killed by bomb explosions in wars that they did not start and are powerless to stop.

Our actions show that we do care and have concern for people who are suffering. Your great generosity to the Lenten Trocaire collection and other groups who help people is a beacon of light. Week in and week out you give to our St Vincent de Paul society.

Jesus says to us every bit as truly as He did to His first followers, ‘*As the Father sent me, so am I sending you.*’ You are a missionary of mercy. Jesus has breathed on you and said to you by name, ‘*Receive the Holy Spirit.*’ You are, and always will be, a Temple of the Holy Spirit. Never were you more needed than today in our war-torn world. We are co-workers with Jesus in saving our world.

Let Holy Cross continue to be a community from whose own suffering, reaches out to others in their suffering. Mercy Sunday asks us to engage in both the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy. You are making a difference. Jesus says to us, “*Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.*” (Gospel of Matthew 5,7)
